

Nurse Extern

Deadline to submit application is January 31st @ 8:00AM

The Nurse Extern, under the direction of a licensed professional nurse, performs care appropriate to the patient population served and meets daily routine patient care needs. The nurse extern may also assist nursing staff by transporting patients, running errands, and transporting equipment to and from units as requested.

Educational Requirements:

- High School graduate or equivalent.
- Must be rising senior nursing student in a BSN program or rising junior in ADN program at the start of the extern program.

Certification/Licensure/Program Requirements:

BLS certification

- Nurse Externs will need to have successfully completed *Fundamentals of Nursing* class during their Sophomore year and are currently enrolled as a Senior Student.
- Nurse Externs must be able to start the program in a PRN status on **May 23rd, 2022**.
- Nurse Externs will be required to complete General and Nursing Orientation during the first week of employment. The following week, Nurse Externs will begin working with their assigned nurse preceptor at a Centra facility and will follow the preceptor's schedule working 32-40 hours per week.
- All Nurse Externs will have the option to transition to a Patient Care Technician (PCT) role up until graduation after the extern program ends on **July 17th, 2022**.

Applicants **MUST** submit the following for the application to be complete and to be considered for an interview:

1. On-Line application
2. Cover letter explaining why you want to work as a Nurse Extern at Centra. Please include your top 2 divisions/units of choice and what location you prefer to work (Lynchburg, Gretna, Bedford, Farmville).
3. Full Resume with contact information for 2 instructor references
